

## 2D Design

### 1. Getting the page set up for drawing on A4

Go to the drop down menu “**Setup**” on the top toolbar and click.

Go to “**Drawing**” and follow the arrow across to “**Layout**” and click.

A window will appear and it will show the TEP cutter set-up.

Click on “**Standard**” button to activate the drop down menu next to it, which usually has ISOA3 on it.

Go to this menu and scroll down, click on ISOA4, then OK

### 2. Setting up the Grids

Go to the grid icon – click right button and the “grid setting” window appears

Set the “Grid Spacing” to 5mm for both X and Y and click OK

Make sure the “**GRID LOCK**” is on; you need to do this for every drawing you start.

**STEP LOCK** is the fine grid and is set to 1mm spacing, this can be changed also but you can not see it on screen.

### 3. Zooming in and out

Use the zoom icons (Magnifying glasses with + and – signs) to go in and out

If you want to zoom into one specific area go to the top tool bar and click on “**View**” and scroll down to “**Zoom in**” this gives you a drag and drop box (i.e. move the cross to the top left hand corner, hold down left button and drag out)
